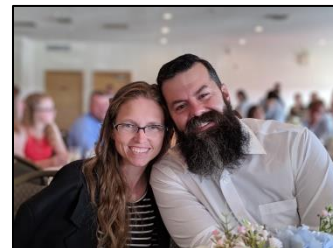
JUNIOR: HAYLEY HARBAUGH & JASON CARMAN

FAQs

How do I contact my child when they are at camp?

We do everything in our power to make you feel as comfortable as possible in leaving your child in our care! We also know that it's hard sometimes to leave your child somewhere or for the child to be left somewhere for any amount of time.

You can contact us on Facebook or email as well but calling the camp phone will be the fastest way to get ahold of us. In the event that we have an emergency - we will call your camper's emergency contact numbers.

How do I get to camp?

West Central Camp is located 3 miles south of La Monte, Missouri, off of 50 hwy.

Coming from the WEST, on 50 hwy, about 5 miles east of Knob Noster, turn south (right) on to Allen Road marked by camp sign and follow signs 2 ½ miles to the camp

Coming from the EAST, on 50 hwy, turn south (left) on Rt 127. After ¾ mile, turn right on first gravel road (Crystal Springs) and follow signs 2 ½ miles to the camp.

Coming from the SOUTH, 2 miles west of Rt. 127, turn north off of Rt. Y at camp sign, onto gravel road (Mahin). Follow signs for 1 ½ miles.

Can I visit my child while they are at camp?

We do allow visitors but are encouraging everyone to limit those visits as we attempt to minimize outside guests during our summer camp sessions. Our visiting hours are from 5:00pm - 9:00pm. You MUST stop by the dining hall to check in for your visitor's pass. Supper is available for donation and we ask that you call ahead so our kitchen staff

knows to prepare more! Please limit your visits to once per camp session.

What about Special Needs campers?

We are not able to accommodate most students with physical disabilities or special needs for our normal camp week settings due to not having appropriately trained staff for that period of time and because of the natural layout of the grounds and facilities.

Started in 2021, we began offering an ALL STARS Day Camp for those living with special needs. This Day Camp is set to give your camper the same camp experience and memories! We hope that we can offer that lifelong memory of summer camp for all students! We do require camper's guardian to be in attendance during our All Stars day camp.

What happens if someone gets sick at camp?

Campers and staff will be educated on early communication if they start feeling sick. If a camper starts to feel ill, they will immediately report to the medic. Based on their symptoms, we will determine if the camper needs to be isolated or not. Our goal will be to remove campers or staff with COVID-19 symptoms from camp as soon as possible, rather than to isolate them for long periods of time. We will not perform or take campers to testing due to turn-around time for results. Parents will be notified if there was a confirmed COVID-19 case at camp so they are aware and can do any follow-up as necessary. Please note that neither masks nor vaccinations are required for anyone attending or working at West Central Christian Service Camp.
